On July 16, 2020, Blackbaud, a software company that serves nonprofit organizations, began notifying its clients of a May 2020 ransomware attack that potentially compromised individually identifiable information of individuals related to those clients. We are working with multiple clients on this matter, most of whom utilized Blackbaud in relation to their charitable foundations. If your organization utilizes Blackbaud, please contact a member of our breach response team and we will guide you through appropriate next steps, including determining whether any notification obligations exist under federal or state law.
